

Dress Code Policy

Attention parents and students: Please note and adhere to the following guidelines for school attire.



Guys and Girls:

- 1) No tight, form fitting tops or pants are accepted.
- 2) Undergarments must not be exposed (guy's boxers; girl's underwear, bra or "cami" straps)
- 3) Jeans must not have excessive threaded patches and can not reveal undergarments or skin.
- 4) Jeans must be high enough on your waist so that your backside is not exposed when sitting down or bending over.
- 5) Logos and messages on clothing must be positive - nothing sexually suggestive
- 6) No pajama pants
- 7) Jewelry should have a positive look (i.e., no spiked collars, bracelets, or belts - no skeletons).
- 9) No backless shoes for grades K-5.
- 10) No visible tattoos.
- 11) No body piercing (i.e. nose-rings, lip-rings). Only girls can wear earrings.
- 12) Moderation in hair style and coloring is expected. (Hair coloring must be natural.)
- 13) No un-hemmed garments.
- 14) No secular band shirts may be worn.

Girls:

Tops:

- 1) No cleavage may be exposed
- 2) No off-the-shoulder or backless attire
- 3) No crop tops - stomachs may not be exposed at any time
- 4) If you wear a tank top, it must have a wide enough strap to cover your bra strap
- 5) Layering is allowed, but camisoles (which are undergarments) may not be the top layer



Shorts / Skirts / Dresses:

1. Shorts must be longer than the length of your longest finger extended to your sides.
2. Skirts and dresses must be of a conservative length - no higher than two inches above the knee.

Dress Code Discipline Policy Contract

1. The first time a student has been spoken to regarding the dress code violation they will be given a verbal warning.
2. The second time a student is spoken to regarding a dress code violation they will be given a note to be signed by the parent, which also needs to be returned the following day. A supervisor will contact the student's parents for a phone conference to discuss the possibility of further disciplinary action.
3. The third time a student is spoken to regarding a dress code violation he or she will be suspended for one day from school. A conference will be scheduled with the Principal, one of our youth pastors, a parent and the student.
4. If a student is spoken to a fourth time, regarding a fourth violation of our policy, they will be expelled from Calvary Christian School (and/or CCS-PSP).

We want to reflect the heart of Christ; those He loves...He disciplines. We have been given many liberties with respect to the dress code this year. We hope that our students realize that to whom much is given, much is required.
